In Fiji, the Department of Corrections collaborates with nearby provinces, placing a focus on aftercare programs to support the reintegration of former offenders into the community.



Problem-Solving Court

In Illinois, Adams County offers a problem-solving court divided into three sections to help repeat offenders: Drug Court, Mental Health Court, and Reintegration into Society (RISE) Court, addressing individual issues to reduce recidivism.
