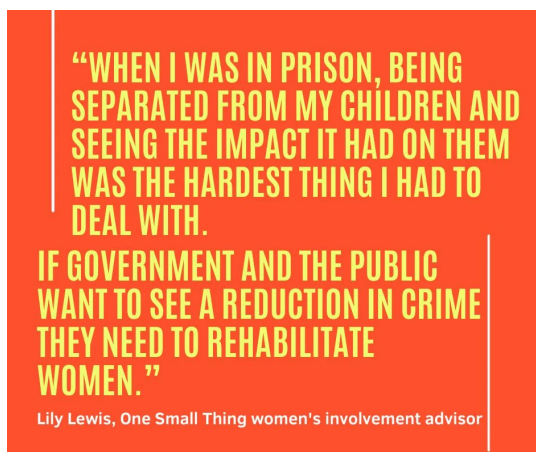

England



Zimbabwe



In Southampton England, the Hope Street scheme works to keep women out of prison by offering a community alternative for women and their children. [Tailored programs](#) aim to help them break the cycle of reoffending.



This [maximum security prison in Zimbabwe](#) offers primary through tertiary education to over 300 inmates as a part of The Zimbabwe Prisons and Correctional Services Rehabilitation program. The headmaster is currently serving an 11 year sentence and will pass on the role upon release.



Japan



India

The Japanese government commissioned a study program for juveniles in cooperation with private schools and tutoring services offering a year of free support. This “social impact bond” program gives adolescents who wish to return to school access to personalized study plans, free tuition, tutoring and social support.

After reviewing prison conditions in India, the Chief Minister in Uttar Pradesh mandated prisons in the region be known as ‘[Reform Homes](#)’ to focus on reformation and rehabilitation.

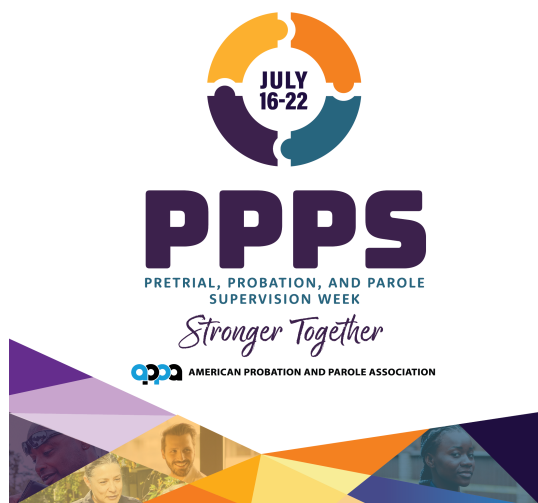
